We are looking for passionate leaders who want to create a better LA for all Angelenos through systems change and public sector service!

The Home For Good Funders Collaborative is excited to continue the **Homelessness Policy Fellowship** for a second year! This one-year, full-time fellowship program (July 2019 – June 2020) places recent graduates with advanced degrees in public agencies and offices working to prevent and end homelessness in LA County. Fellows will be embedded on current teams and engage directly in homeless systems projects related to policy and planning. Our new cohort will join existing fellows who have been working in LA County Supervisor, LA City Councilmember, and LA County DMH offices to strengthen efforts to end homelessness. The Homelessness Policy Fellowship is a truly unique opportunity for recent graduates to work with top public sector systems leaders and local public leadership while gaining firsthand experience tackling one of LA's most challenging and critical issues – homelessness.

FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM BENEFITS:

- **Stipend:** Annual stipend of \$60,000
