



## FELLOWSHIP OVERVIEW

### WHAT

- The Home For Good Funders Collaborative is a group of private and public partners that jointly invest in systems and solutions to end homelessness in LA County. As part of our commitment to the growth of solutions and future of our sector, we are proud to continue the **Homelessness Policy Fellowship Program** for a second year!

### WHO

- For individuals who have recently graduated from a master's level program (within past 2 years) OR will have graduated by the time fellowship starts in July 2019. Looking for leaders who are committed to ending homelessness in LA and working with public sector partners focused on systemic change to end homelessness.

### WHY

- To further Los Angeles' community plan to end and prevent homelessness through systemic change work by supporting public sector partners and their agencies to work with and mentor recently graduated students.
- To ensure a pipeline of new public and nonprofit leaders interested in a career in ending homelessness

### WHEN

April 30, 2019	Online application deadline at 11:59 p.m.
Early May 2019	Candidates will be contacted for interviews
Early June 2019	Fellows will be selected
July 2019 through June 2020	Fellows participate in systems fellowship program

### WHERE

Our new cohort will join existing fellows who have been working in LA County Supervisor, LA City Councilmember, and LA County DMH offices to strengthen efforts to end homelessness. The following public agencies/offices will each be welcoming one fellow to join their team for 2019-2020:

- City of Pomona
- City of Long Beach

### ABOUT THE PROGRAM

- Receive a stipend of \$60,000 through a consulting contract directly with United Way of Greater Los Angeles. Stipends will be supported through private philanthropic funding through the Home For Good Funders Collaborative.
- Serve full-time, estimated at 40 hours/week, (including non-commute related travel time associated with activities related to fellowship), with the agency for a full year.
- Work will be 100 percent dedicated to tasks and/or projects related to ending homelessness.
- Work closely with a designated staff member whose work is dedicated at least 50 percent or more to homelessness. All assigned projects for the fellow must be integrated into the work of the agency.
- Attend and participate in a minimum of one external meeting per month related to ending and/or preventing homelessness as well as cohort learning sessions and individual check-ins coordinated by United Way.
- Engage on a project in partnership with the agency staff member and/or their cohort toward ending and preventing homelessness.
