



Capacity Building - Request for Proposals

Application Period Open Now!

Are you a homeless services provider in Los Angeles County? In the last few years, has your organization experienced significant growth and an increase in demand for services? Are you looking for funding to strengthen and support your operational infrastructure and internal processes? Then you may be interested in the **updated** Capacity Building Request for Proposals (RFP), supported by the Los Angeles Homeless Services Agency (LAHSA) and United Way's Home for Good Funders Collaborative.

Funding Opportunity: The Capacity Building RFP is open to all Los Angeles County homeless services agencies and non-profit housing developers that are in need of funding to address capacity building projects and have not previously received funding through this joint RFP. The overall goal is to help organizations providing housing services to enhance service delivery to unhoused individuals in the community and progress towards achieving their missions. Examples of eligible funding include:

- IT systems upgrades (computers, laptops, software, databases, and licenses)
- Fundraising and resource development
- Leadership development and specialized training for board and organization staff
- Development of policies and procedures related to human resources and finance
- Design of contracts and grants management systems

Funding Available: Awarded agencies qualify for up to \$100,000 in Measure H public funding and private funding through the Home for Good Funders Collaborative. The funding represents the public-private investment in strengthening homeless services agencies across the county. All awarded agencies contract directly through the United Way of Greater Los Angeles.

Deadline: All applications are due by 8 a.m. PDT on Monday, February 17, 2020 via email to rfp@unitedwayla.org. Applications are no longer accepted on a rolling basis. Award announcements are anticipated in April 2020.
