The Funders Collaborative is one of the strongest engines fueling Home For Good's collective impact initiative.

WHO WE ARE

Founded in 2011 with a \$1m challenge grant from the Conrad N. Hilton Foundation, the Home For Good Funders Collaborative brings together public agencies and private philanthropy to invest in solutions to homelessness in L.A. County.

The coalition promotes public and privately-funded opportunities to a broad network of individuals and organizations who meet monthly to discuss and align on the allocation of resources for housing and homelessness.

Home For Good is a cross-sector initiative of United Way of Greater L.A. (UWGLA), which is on a mission to permanently break the cycle of poverty for our most vulnerable neighbors: low-income families, students, veterans, and people experiencing homelessness. Home For Good develops, implements, and scales solutions that further United Way's mission.

OUR APPROACH

We optimize public and private resources. The Funders Collaborative invests private dollars to test bold innovations, evaluates their success and sustainability against specific goals and metrics, and leverages public dollars to bring the most effective solutions to scale.

OUR IMPACT

We have raised and aligned more than \$62 million in private funding and leveraged more than \$5 billion in public resources. As a result, our community has been able to:

- Provide nearly a decade of capacity-building support for core housing developers in L.A. County, doubling the supportive housing pipeline
- Coordinate a \$5M joint public-private Capacity Building RFP for organizations providing services and support for residents in need
- Develop and invest in the countywide expansion of the Coordinated Entry System (CES), which fundamentally changed how we match clients to housing resources across the nation
- Coordinate the first systemic pairing of private and public funds to dedicated vouchers for chronically homeless clients
- Seed the launch of the Homelessness Policy Research Institute, which has become the lead facilitator for local homelessness and housing research
- Fund piloting of new types of system coordination positions, including housing navigators in emergency departments and cross-hospital liaison positions
